



SHUTTER MECHANISM WATCHES

OPERATING THE SHUTTER MECHANISM

- Type 1) Turn bezel to view time/date
- Type 2) Push both buttons on side of case at the same time to view time/date.
- Type 3) Turn sliding lever to view time/date.

The shutter designs are collectable watches with many moving parts and so care must be taken when operating the shutter mechanism. They should not be regarded as a toy, and should be kept away from children.

The shutter mechanism is delicate and should not be exposed to rigorous or excessive use. To view time/ date, the shutter should be opened gently, and not be forced or over worked as this may cause damage.

Shutter mechanism watches are **not water resistant** and so the item must be kept away from water, excessive amounts of moisture, steam and condensation e.g. bathroom/shower. This is to avoid rust from building up and causing internal damage, which may prevent the shutters from working correctly.

If the shutter mechanism becomes jammed, do not apply force to open/close it as this may cause further damage to the shutters. If this occurs, the watch should be returned to our Service Dept for repair.

Any manufacturing defect will be covered under your one year Guarantee. However, any mishandling or inappropriate use of the watch or shutter mechanism will invalidate this.

CLEANING AND SERVICING

It is possible that dust may enter the watch case and become visible beneath the watch glass. Should this happen, our service dept provides cleaning and servicing for all **STORM** shutter mechanism watches. Your guarantee includes your first cleaning service free of charge, within the Guarantee period. After this there may be a charge for this service; please contact our service Dept for instructions for returning your watch and further information on the service provided.

YOU SHOULD NOT ATTEMPT TO DISMANTLE THE SHUTTER MECHANISM OR CLEAN THE WATCH YOURSELF, AS THIS MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE MECHANISM AND WILL ALSO INVALIDATE YOUR GUARANTEE.

All servicing/cleaning must be carried out by either our Service Dept or by a qualified jeweller/watch maker. Any damage caused as a result of inexpert repair will invalidate the Guarantee and charges may apply to correct the damage.
